Technical Information

GAME PROTOCOL

Prior to the start of each game, teams will be asked to line up on each side of centre field, facing the stands. Official introductions of each team's starting eleven players,

coaching staff and game referees will be announced. For all games the introductions will be followed by the singing/playing of our National Anthem.

PLAYER OF THE GAME

A player of the game will be selected from each team at the conclusion of every semi final game. Teams will be asked to line-up on each side of centre at midfield, facing the stands after each game. The Player of the Game will be announced by a member of the all-star committee and teams may then proceed to shake hands. Player of the Game recipients will receive a sponsored award.

MAJOR AND MINOR OFFICIALS

Game officials will be provided according to the CCAA guidelines. Four officials will be used for each game and will be assigned by the championship allocator.

Minor officials for all games will be provided by Holland College Athletics. Minor officials for the championships will include announcers for each game as well as ball retrievers.

VIDEO TAPING

The Gold Medal Games will be video taped. Copies of game tapes may be purchased for \$15.00. All game tapes will be copied and sent to CCAA colleges for the CCAA Nationals.

MEDICAL SERVICES

The Sports Centre Physiotherapy Team will be available for the weekend to attend to the needs of the athletes. Each team will be responsible for supplying their taping and medical supplies. Ice will be made available.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control may be conducted during these championships. Please ensure that all athletes are aware of this CCAA requirement.
